Business arising from the minutes of the meeting of June 8, 2004 – Item 3 to be amended as follows: Councillor Legendre reported that the Manor Park Plaza had been bought by a new developer and that the mall would be redeveloped. The mall has not been sold.

Item 1 – To review and amend the bylaws to read that there should be no more than sixteen and no fewer than ten members on the board of directors. A motion was put forward by Robert Todd and seconded by Jeffery Thiessen. The motion was carried. A slate of members to be presented as directors will be presented at the A.G.M.

Item 2 – The dinner dance: In charge of the dinner dance is Mary Hickman, Marie-France Senecal, Caroline Klug, Loie Macdougall, and Pilar Doe. A contract has been ratified with the Canada Aviation Museum by the association to hold the dinner dance there. A 25% deposit had to be paid to reserve the museum. A draft budget will be presented at the next meeting.

Item 3 – Karen Way: Ewan and John Mark Keys from the Karen Way Committee brought forward the shocking condition in which Richcraft has left the school on Karen Way. Richcraft is demolishing the building, but is creating a dangerous condition by leaving the fence down and creating a hazardous condition for the children of the area. The city has been notified and has sent out an inspector.

Item 4 – Neighbourhood Watch: The Karen Way committee brought to Mr. Todd's attention that there has been vandalism in the Hemlock Park.

Item 5 – Website: We have a new web manager, Allison Simpkins, who will give the Manor Park web site a new look. We are looking for a new web master.

Item 6 – Kettle Island Bridge: There is an in-depth study next month regarding four sites for the bridges and the impact on the environment.

Item 7 – The Marsh: Marie-Chantal Ross spent the summer cleaning up the marsh in our area and would like the residents of Manor Park to help in keeping this area clean.
