Item 1 – Treasury Report: There is a healthy bank account. Fifty dollars was needed for the chronicle, Inez Sunderland made the motion for the expenditure, and Patrick O’Keefe seconded the motion. The motion was carried.

Item 2 – Dinner Dance: Tickets will be on sale starting Dec. 6, 2004, and it will be a sit-down dinner. Loie Macdougall will be selling the tickets.

Item 3 – Karen Way: The Karen Way committee met with Jacques Legendre and with the city planner Gordon Harrison on Nov. 4, 2004. The committee found that the city planners were favouring Richcraft. The committee held an information night at St. David and St. Martin Church on Nov. 23, 2004. A letter writing campaign and a petition signing were held there. The committee will take this petition through the neighbourhood for the residents to sign.

Item 4 – Jacques Legendre: Councillor Legendre has put forward that the building be no higher than 5 storeys on the St. Laurent side and 3 storeys on the Karen Way side. He would like this to be a transition area between Brittany Dr. and Hemlock Rd. Councillor Legendre also wanted a volunteer to stand on the Beechwood steering committee. Robert Valliquette volunteered for this position.

Item 5 – Development Committee: The committee held its first meeting in the first week in November and the second meeting was held on Nov. 17, 2004. There they discussed forming a community plan for the neighbourhood and for the surrounding area.
