Approval of the Agenda: A motion was made by Robert Bennett and seconded by Robert Todd to accept the agenda as is. Motion carried.

Minutes of the meeting of Dec. 14: A motion was made by Inez Sunderland to accept the minutes of the meeting as is and it was seconded by Patrick O’Keefe. The motion was carried.

Item 1 – Volunteer Recognition: The Manor Park community would like to recognize the contribution by volunteers in the neighbourhood. David Goldfield and Inez Sunderland will work on different concepts to bring this about.

Item 2 – Toastmasters Proposal: Response to the proposal by the toastmasters to expand the field house was positive. Lana Burpee has agreed to act as the liaison person between the city and the community. The toastmasters will have an open house on Jan. 20, 2005, at the field house at 7:30 pm.

Item 3 – Treasurer’s Report: Money has been taken out of the I.N.G. account and put into the bank account to help with expenses of the dinner dance.

Item 4 – Dinner Dance: The dinner dance will be held on Jan. 29, 2005, at the Aviation Museum. Tickets are still available and are on sale for \$55. There have been 220 tickets sold.

Item 5 – Councillor Jacques Legendre Report: The meeting before the planning committee has been postponed indefinitely. RichCraft has rethought their position on the construction of the building on Karen Way. Councillor Legendre is concerned about an amendment in regards to compatibility by the O.M.B. and how it will affect the neighbourhoods. The R.C.M.P. would like to expand and modernize the police college and would like neighbourhood input. They will have a meeting on March 7, 2005, at Manor Park School at 7:30 pm.

Item 6 – The development committee: The three tiers of Government have agreed to a study regarding the ring road and the Kettle Island Bridge.

Item 7 – Karen Way: Mr. Keys and Councillor Legendre met with RichCraft who have agreed to another public meeting about changes they are willing to make concerning the construction and what will be built on the Karen Way site.

Item 8 – The Manor Park web site: The web site has been redesigned and will be relaunched in the near future. The web site will have an index page, a drop down menu page and content pages. The minutes of the meetings of the Community Association will be posted on the web. The Manor Park web site would like input from the community about experiences of the residents of Manor Park. Pertinent information such as garbage collection or what is happening at the school, and what new residents need to know will also be posted on the web site.
