Item 1 – History Project: Dawn Logan will be heading up a history project, looking at documents and articles, some from the 1971 historical archives. Manor Park was one of the first communities to be laid out as it is. She will be doing her research from the grassroots e.g., public library, C.M.H.C., and the N.C.C. Also Ms. Logan will be interviewing the local residents of Manor Park.

Item 2 – Dinner Dance: 180 tickets have been sold and they are looking at selling at least 255 tickets. A motion was made to give the committee up to \$500 to cover possible costs of the dinner. The motion was made by David Goldfield and seconded by John Forsey. The motion was carried.
